Companions for people with refugee and migration experience in Treptow-Köpenick



Spend time together

Tandem partners spend time together:

-  around 2-3 hours per week,
-  chatting together, going for walks exploring the neighborhood, doing sport together or visiting parks with children,
-  and take part in free events and activities organized by KIEZTANDEM.

In addition, people who are new to Berlin may also request:

- general social advice,
- advice and accompaniment into volunteering activities in the local area.

What do you gain?

-  Make new friends and acquaintances
-  Get to know your neighborhood
-  Practice speaking German
-  Share hobbies (cooking, woodwork, arts and crafts, sport, languages, dancing...) and discover new hobbies for yourself or your family
-  Have a contact person on your side who can offer support with small bureaucratic matters
-  Professional support on behalf of the project team
-  If requested, advice on how to get involved in volunteering in your local neighborhood
-  social advice



Who can take part?

People with refugee experience who

-  currently live in Treptow-Köpenick
-  enjoy conversation and like taking part in group activities
-  are willing to take part in group meetings and events (e.g. excursions)
-  can speak German at minimum A2 level
-  are at least 18 years old

Who are the tandem partners?

The tandem partners work on a **voluntary basis**. This means that they do not receive any money for this task. They do it voluntarily in their free time. The tandem partners are not trained professionals or social workers.
